Therese Virserius Design Chosen for Hyatt Pittsburgh

Therese Virserius Design of New York City has been selected to design the lobby, lounge, and restaurant at the Hyatt Pittsburgh. The lobby lounge will feature a glowing L-shaped bar topped with white marble and gold veining. Black lacquer screens with LED lighting will provide separation of the space, while a wood communal table in the center of the lounge reflects the design's references to nature.

Meanwhile, the restaurant's design elements include rugs with Japanese-inspired floral images, an over-scaled wall sculpture, purple tweed and earth-toned banquettes, and macassa ebony veneer tables. Project construction will begin in March 2009.
